

Library Instruction Services at the Gwendolyn Brooks Library (Spring 2023)

Any member of the **CSU faculty (full-time or adjunct)** may request a library instruction (or bibliographic instruction) session for a class. Library instruction sessions can be general in focus, customized for a **specific** academic discipline, or geared towards a **particular** course assignment. Library instruction services are available during the following hours:

- Monday-Thursday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Saturday, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Please submit library instruction session requests at least 1 week in advance of the desired date. Instruction sessions are available in the following delivery modes:

- In-person, taught in the Library Instruction Lab, LIB 210, in the Gwendolyn Brooks Library
- Live-online, taught in a Virtual Library Instruction Lab via Zoom
- Pre-recording, recorded instruction session using Zoom.

The ideal time for an instruction session is 2 to 3 weeks before the related class assignment is due. However, the timing is entirely up to the course instructor. In the case of **pre-recorded** sessions, the **date/time** selected on the *Library Instruction* calendar will indicate the date/time by which the recording should be **delivered** to the course instructor. The requested "delivery date" should be at least 1 week away.

Requests should be submitted using the library's online instruction request system, located at: http://csu.libcal.com/booking/libraryinstruction

The course instructor will receive an **immediate** response **via email** that the request is under review by the Library Instruction Coordinator. Meanwhile, the requested date/time is reserved on the instruction calendar. Once an instruction request has been approved, **confirmation** will be sent **via email**.
